## **Roles & Responsibilities within Devon Hockey**

### **Devon Hockey Association**

- Collect Affiliation Fees from clubs
- Act as the man mode of communication between England Hockey, West Association with the clubs and schools
- Running of senior and junior club competitions
- Oversee the running of the SSMG
- Collect and spend funds collected from players, clubs, schools and through grants etc appropriately as directed by the executive with guidance provided by the Single System Management Group

### **Devon Hockey Single System Management Group (SSMG)**

- Organise and manage the Junior Development Centres
- Organise and manage Junior Academy Centres in partnership with the school associations
- Organise the assessments and JDC competitions
- Track players and coaches through the SS Pathway

### **Devon School Girls Association (DSGA)**

- Collect Affiliation Fees from schools
- Run the area and County U14, U16 and U18 school competitions
- Run the school U11 and U13 mini competitions

### **Devon School Boys Association (DSBA)**

- Run the area and County U14, U16 and U18 school competitions
- Run the school U11 and U13 mini competitions

## **Umpiring in Devon**

The development of umpiring in Devon is undertaken by Devon Umpires who works in partnership with Devon Hockey. The Umpire association appoints umpires from a pool of umpires for a range of school and club competitions and leagues. For more information on umpiring for all ages please visit the joint DHA and Devon Umpires web site.

Devon HUA is now running the Devon Young Umpires Action Group (DYUAG) whose aim is to develop young people of all ages to umpire. The young umpires who are part of the group receive coaching and instruction in the art of umpiring and will be eligible to be appointed to Youth events within the County with progression to the WYUAG (West) and on to the NYUAG (National). DYUAG are prepared to develop and run courses for clubs and schools to help develop their young people.

## RULES OF HOCKEY 2009-10 - FREE HIT GUIDANCE ISSUED TO UMPIRES (May 2009)

For free hits (including centre passes, corners and all sideline restarts after the ball has been outside the field)

- All **opponents** must be at least 5 metres from the ball

For free hits awarded to the **attack** within their attacking 23 metre area

- All **players** must be at least 5 metres from the ball

*In all situations - if taken quickly and a player is within 5 metres of the ball but is not playing, attempting to play the ball or influencing play, the taking of the free hit does not need to be delayed – be consistent in your judgment of this*

Attacking free hits awarded **within 5 metres** of the circle must be taken **back to the nearest point 5 metres from the circle**

.....  
A player taking a free hit, centre pass, corner or sideline restart can be the next player to play the ball – a **'self-pass'**:

- Taking the free hit and the next playing of the ball must be **two distinct and separate** actions.

The ball does **not** have to move 1 metre before the player may play the ball again.

At a free hit, which is not a 'self-pass', the ball must move at least **1 metre** before it can be played by a teammate of the player taking the free hit

.....  
For free hits (including corners and sideline restarts) taken by the **attacking team inside the 23** metre area the ball **cannot** be played **directly into the circle**

- At a 'self-pass' the ball **must travel** at least 5 metres from the point of the free hit (not necessarily in a single direction) before the taker himself can play the ball into the circle.

- Alternatively the ball must be touched, deflected, hit or pushed by **any other player before either it enters or can be played** into the circle.

.....  
For free hits (including corners and sideline restarts) taken by the **attacking team** inside the 23 metre area

- Be **pro-active** and use your common sense regarding the **placement** of free hits either close to the circle or the 23 metre line

- Be flexible, only penalise if the 'wrong spot' for the free hit is chosen in order to either **gain an unfair advantage** or for reasons which are **against the spirit and aim of the Rules**

- Intentionally moving the location of an attacking free hit outside the 23 metre area to create an opportunity to play the ball directly into the circle **must** be seen as an unfair advantage and **penalised accordingly**

.....  
For a free hit taken by the **attacking team** within their attacking 23 metre area which is played directly into the circle

- Do **not** penalise **unless and until** the ball actually enters the circle. A free hit is awarded to the opposing team from the spot where the free hit was incorrectly executed

- Award the appropriate penalty for infringements and be aware of break down play situations, intentional interference with free hits etc. Use technical and personal penalties as required or appropriate.

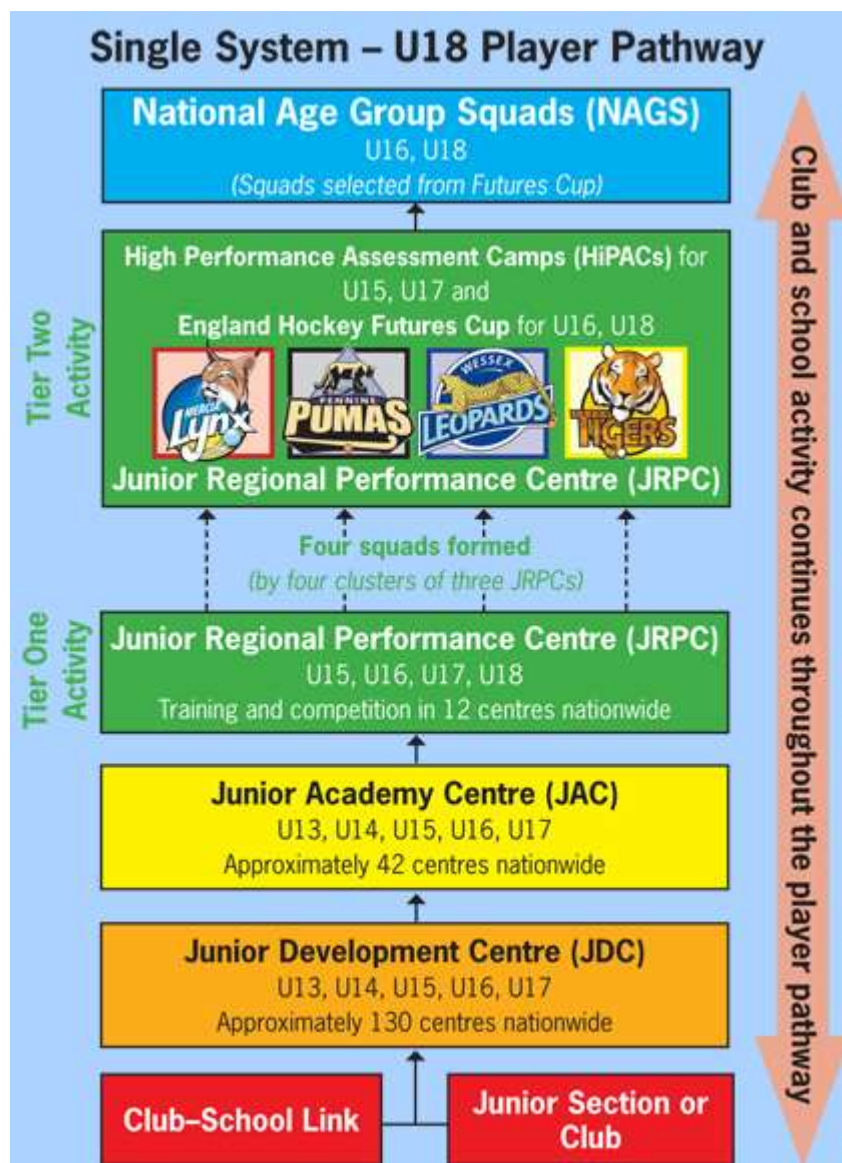

## Single System - Junior Development Centres, Junior Academy Centres and Regional Performance Centres



### Devon Player Pathway for Boys and Girls 2009-10

In order to progress up the Player Pathway firstly you have to attend your nearest Junior Development Assessment Centre (**JDC**). These centres will run training sessions between September and December 2009 in line with the England Hockey Centralised Calendar. Players are nominated by their school and/or club to attend a JDC assessment.

Devon JDC's are based at;

- West Plymouth
- East Exeter
- South Ashburton
- North Barnstaple

Some players will be nominated by their JDC Lead Coach to attend a Junior Academy Centre (JAC) assessment in January 2010. The JAC's are based in Exeter and centres will run for U14, U15 and U17 boys and girls. These JAC's will run from January through to April 2010.

From the JACs a team will be selected to represent the county at the regional JAC U14, U15 and U17 boys and girls competitions which will in March and April 2010. At these JAC competitions players will be assessed for the Junior Regional Performance Centres which will be based at Exeter and Bristol.

Please note that the age groups are based on the 1<sup>st</sup> January and NOT school years. Therefore it is the **YEAR THAT THE PLAYER IS BORN IN** that determines which age group centre they attend. See table below.

### National Mini Hockey Championships 2009-10

1. All Devon affiliated schools are entitled to take part in the Championships.
2. Schools may ONLY ENTER one team per age group.
3. All players must be either Under 11 or Under 13 on 31 August 2010.
4. Girl teams at Under 11 and Under 13 must consist of girls only.
5. Boys teams at Under 11 can consist of girls but at Under 13 must consist of boys only.
6. Each squad may comprise of a maximum of ten players.
7. All rounds will be played in accordance with Rules of Mini Hockey, copies of which may be obtained from England Hockey. Copies of the full regulations for the Championships are available from County Organisers.
